WHAT WILL I LEARN?

Advanced anatomy and physiology (including a human cadaver lab); how to communicate with patients in 2 or more languages; how to deal with medical emergencies; patient care and relationships; community service; and medical ethical principles



WHAT WILL I DO?

Learn to take blood pressures; learn emergency first aid procedures; job shadow at various health care facilities; complete internships; work as a student athletic trainer; work on projects with Alzheimer's patients; and more



WHAT WILL I EARN?

Red Cross emergency medical responder certification; bi-lingual medical terminology certification; college credits while in high school; and respect and appreciation from your community
